In the appeals of Mr Bosco Ntaganda and the Prosecutor against the 'Judgment' of

Trial Chamber VI of 8 July 2019 (ICC-01/04-02/06-2359),

Chamber VI of 7 November 2019 (ICC-01/04-02/06-2442),

Having before it the 'Submission of Request Pursuant to Regulation 78 of the

Regulations of the Court' of 10 February 2020 (ICC-01/04-02/06-2469),

Pursuant to regulation 78(1) of the Regulations of Court,

Renders the following

DECISION

Mr Christopher Gosnell's request for leave to withdraw as Associate Counsel

in the above-mentioned appeals is granted.

REASONS

1. On 10 February 2020, Lead Counsel for Mr Bosco Ntaganda filed the

'Submission of Request Pursuant to Regulation 78 of the Regulations of the Court'

(the 'Request'), in which Mr Christopher Gosnell requests leave to withdraw as

Associate Counsel.² Mr Gosnell provides a reason for his withdrawal and submits

that, given the stage of the proceedings and the composition of the defence team, his

withdrawal will cause no prejudice to the representation of Mr Ntaganda or to the

expeditious conduct of proceedings.³ Mr Gosnell undertakes to adhere to the Code of

Professional Conduct for counsel, including in respect of confidentiality and record-

keeping. Lead Counsel for Mr Ntaganda submits that he fully supports Mr Gosnell's request and that Mr Ntaganda has been consulted.⁵

- The Appeals Chamber notes the reasons advanced by Associate Counsel for his withdrawal from representation. It observes that Mr Ntaganda has been consulted and that he continues to be represented by Lead Counsel and other members of the defence team. The Appeals Chamber further notes the Associate Counsel's undertaking to comply fully with all ongoing obligations under the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel.
- 3. In view of the foregoing, the Request is granted.
