Prosecution request for reclassification

- 1. On 14 April 2020, the Prosecution filed the "Prosecution's provision of information in relation to further written submissions".1 The same day, the Prosecution filed a corrigendum of this filing ("Corrigendum"),2 together with an annex explaining the correction made ("Annex").3 The Prosecution filed the Corrigendum and Annex confidentially as they referred to the contents of a confidential filing by the Defence for Mr Gbagbo ("Defence filing").4
- 2. Since the Defence filing has been reclassified to public pursuant to the Chamber's order of 11 May 2020,5 there is no longer a basis for maintaining the confidentiality of the Corrigendum and the Annex.
- 3. Accordingly, and pursuant to the Chamber's order dated 17 June 2020,6 the Prosecution requests that the Corrigendum and the Annex be reclassified to public.
