Judge Bertram Schmitt, acting as Single Judge on behalf of Trial Chamber V of the International Criminal Court, in the case of The Prosecutor v. Alfred Yekatom and Patrice-Edouard Ngaïssona, having regard to Articles 60(2) and (3), 61(11) and 64(6)(a) of the Rome Statute, Rule 118(1) and (2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and Regulation 51 of the Regulations of the Court issues this 'Order Requesting Observations from relevant States on Interim Release'.

- 1. On 11 November 2018, Pre-Trial Chamber II issued a warrant of arrest against Mr Yekatom. On 17 November 2018, the Central African Republic (the 'CAR') authorities surrendered him to the Court.²
- 2. On 3 March 2020, the Yekatom Defence (the 'Defence') requested Mr Yekatom's interim release to the CAR.³ After having sought and received observations from the CAR and the Kingdom of the Netherlands, as the host State (hereinafter: 'the Netherlands'),4 the Chamber assessed and rejected this request on 28 April 2020.⁵
- 3. On 27 July 2020, the Defence requested the Chamber to release Mr Yekatom to the Kingdom of Belgium (hereinafter: 'Belgium') pending trial under such conditions that the Chamber deems necessary (the 'Request').⁶
- 4. For the purposes of the upcoming decision on the Request, the Single Judge seeks observations from Belgium by 19 August 2020. Further, the Single Judge takes note of the observations previously made by the Netherlands in relation to

the Defence's first request for interim release.⁷ Should the Dutch authorities wish to make further observations in relation to the present Request, they are invited to do so by the same date. The Chamber will decide if further responses to these observations are necessary once they have been received.

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS, THE SINGLE JUDGE HEREBY

ORDERS the Registry to invite Belgium and the Netherlands to submit any observations on Mr Yekatom's interim release by 19 August 2020.
