I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Prosecution hereby notifies Trial Chamber I ("Chamber") of the disclosure of evidence pursuant to articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute, and rules 76(3) and 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

II. CLASSIFICATION

2. This filing is classified as public with one confidential annex, comprising the list of evidence disclosed to the Defence. This annex is classified as confidential since it contains confidential information.

III. SUBMISSIONS

- 3. Between 22 and 25 March 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence seven packages of evidence consisting of 72 items (298 pages):
 - Pre-Trial INCRIM package 109, containing 21 items (115 pages), including material related to 5 witnesses;¹
 - Pre-Trial INCRIM package 110, consisting of 10 items (63 pages), including material related to DAR-OTP-P-0999;
 - Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 69, containing 5 items (18 pages), including material related to DAR-OTP-P-0087;
 - Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 70, consisting of 7 items (32 pages), including material related to 4 witnesses;²
 - Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 71, consisting of 2 items (13 pages), including material related to DAR-OTP-P-1042;
 - Pre-Trial Metadata Re-issue package 23, consisting of 24 items (51 pages) with certain metadata fields re-issued;³ and

- Pre-Trial Image update package 03, consisting of 3 items (6 pages), including one item related to DAR-OTP-P-0585,⁴ and two items related to the biometric examination of Mr Abd-Al-Rahman.⁵
- 4. With respect to redactions, the Prosecution applied "standard" redactions to new items pursuant to the procedure for exceptions to disclosure adopted by the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II on 17 August 2020.6
