I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Prosecution hereby notifies Trial Chamber I ("Chamber") of the disclosure of evidence pursuant to articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute, and rules 76(3) and 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

II. CLASSIFICATION

2. This filing is classified as public with one confidential annex, comprising the list of evidence disclosed to the Defence. This annex is classified as confidential since it contains confidential information.

III. SUBMISSIONS

- 3. Between 8 and 10 June 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence 7 packages of evidence, consisting of 71 items (146 pages):
 - Trial INCRIM package 130, consisting of 11 items (12 pages), including material related to 2 witnesses;¹
 - Trial INCRIM package 131, consisting of 1 item (26 pages), including material related to DAR-OTP-P-0726;
 - Trial INCRIM package 132, consisting of 49 items (67 pages), including material related to DAR-OTP-P-0726 and satellite images;
 - Trial Rule 77 package 89, consisting of 5 items (21 pages), including material related to 3 witnesses;²
 - Trial Rule 77 package 90, consisting of 1 item (2 pages), including material related to DAR-OTP-P-0547;
 - Trial Rule 77 package 91, consisting of 3 items (15 pages), including material related to 2 witnesses;³ and
