### AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATIONS OF THE REGISTRY

The Presidency approved the Regulations of the Registry on 6 March 2006 in accordance with Rule 14 (1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

The revised version of the Regulations of the Registry (ICC-BD/03-01-06-Rev.1) dated 25 September 2006 amended the following errors (inserted text is marked in bold, whilst deletions are struck out):

- French version only: Regulations 135 (now entitled Disputes relating to fees) and 136 (now entitled Legal aid commissioners)

Regulations 135 and 136 erroneously duplicated Regulations 157 and 158, respectively. The erroneous text was deleted and the correct regulations inserted.

- English version only: Regulation 166 (Personal belongings of detained persons)

An extra negation was erroneously included in Regulation 166 (7). The word “not” was deleted.

Regulation 166 (7): *“The possession or consumption of alcohol and/or drugs other than for medical purposes shall ~~not~~ be prohibited”*.

- Both French and English versions: Regulation 183 (Supervision of visits)

Regulation 183 (1) erroneously referred to Regulation 185 as opposed to Regulation 188. Reference to Regulation 188 was replaced by reference to Regulation 185.

Regulation 183 (1): *“Visits shall be conducted within the sight and hearing of the staff of the detention centre and shall be monitored by video surveillance. In addition to visits falling within regulations 97, sub-regulation 2, and 98, sub-regulation 2, of the Regulations of the Court, visits from representatives of the independent inspecting authority and officers of the Court, shall be conducted within the sight but not the hearing, either direct or indirect, of the staff of the detention centre. Private visits as referred to in regulation ~~188~~ **185** shall not be supervised”*.
