## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

## Explanation of the changes made:

- 1.-The table on the cover page has been modified in the public version, but only to indicate that the original brief dated February 28, 2023 was considered as "CONFIDENTIAL EX PARTE only available to the Prosecution with Annexes 1 to 13. "CONFIDENTIAL EX PARTE only available to the Prosecution with Annexes 1 to 13 CONFIDENTIAL EX PARTE only available to the Office of the Prosecutor" and the public version is now to be considered as "PUBLIC with Annexe 4, 5,6, 7 and 8 PUBLIC and Annexes 1, 2,3, 9 to 13 CONFIDENTIAL EX PARTE only available to the Office of the Prosecutor".
- 2.- The index, having fewer pages in the whole document, because it has consigned as "REDACTED" sentences and even whole paragraphs, must necessarily change, since a specific heading changes location of the document and, obviously, since the number of pages is smaller, this circumstance causes the of pages, this circumstance means that the pagination has to change as well. Paragraph 57 in the public version is indicated as "REDACTED", but then the text corresponding to this paragraph in the public version is included.
- 3.- Paragraph 57 in the public version is indicated as "REDACTED", but then the text corresponding to said paragraph in the original version of February 28, 2023 is included as paragraph 58. This means that from that point on, the public version appears with this new numbering, which is nothing more than the result of the new numbering, which is the result of a mechanical error in having erroneously included this paragraph 57. This is the reason why the original version has 202 paragraphs and the public version has 203. This paragraph 57 has been deleted and renumbered again, with the one in the public version appearing as paragraph 58. public version as 58, again as paragraph 57, which is correct, the public version document then has exactly the same paragraphs as in the original version.
- 4. On several occasions, when "REDACTED" was placed in some parts of paragraphs, the footnotes corresponding to these deleted parts (i.e. §60 NPP 57; §94 NPP 92; §113 NPP 112). This mechanical error has been corrected by adding back the footnotes but putting the contents of the footnotes but putting the original content of the footnotes as "REDACTED". In short, the basic content of both documents has not changed in any case, other than to remove those data that should remain confidential, to include names of persons, etc.
