Agreed Facts Related to Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman’s background

	Agreed fact
1.	Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman’s Civil Registration card and Personal Identification card record that he was born in 1949 [DAR-OTP-0216-0241, translation at DAR-OTP-0216-0773; DAR-OTP-0216-0235, translation at DAR-OTP-0216-0765].
2.	Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman is a Sudanese citizen.
3.	Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman is Muslim.
4.	Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman belongs to the Ta’aisha tribe.
5.	The Ta’aisha tribe is generally considered an Arab tribe in Sudan.
6.	Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman speaks Arabic.
7.	Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman’s Personal Identification card records that he was born in Rahad Al-Berdi (South Darfur) [DAR-OTP-0216-0235, translation at DAR-OTP-0216-0765].
8.	The full name of Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman is formed of a series of names corresponding to his descent. It is a common practice in Sudan for names to be composed in this manner.

9.	A certificate from the Council of Medical Assistance and Technical Professions states that Mr Ali Muhammad Ali qualified as a medical assistant in 1984 [DAR-D31-0001-0001, translation at DAR-D31-0001-0005].
10.	Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman retired from the Sudanese Armed Forces in around the early to middle 1990s. Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman was formerly part of the Medical Corps of the Sudanese Armed Forces.
11.	Upon retirement from the Sudanese Armed Forces in around the early to middle 1990s, Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman opened a shop in Garsila from which he sold medication.
12.	As of 10 April 2012, Mr Ali Muhammad Ali was in possession of a licence from the Federal Council for Pharmaceuticals and Toxicology to sell medicine [DAR-D31-0001-0003, translation at DAR-D31-0001-0006].
13.	An Order for Assignment of police recruits dated 28 July 2005, signed by the Commander of the Central Reserve Forces, states that Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman was a member of a group of the Central Reserve Police [DAR-D31-0002-0003, translation at DAR-D31-0002-0007].
14.	Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman's shop in Garsila was one among many shops situated near the Agricultural Bank.
15.	Upon retirement from the Sudanese Armed Forces in around the early to middle 1990s, Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman lived in Garsila.
16.	Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman has a son named Salah Ali Mohammed.
17.	Salah Ali Mohammed accompanied Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman when he surrendered to the International Criminal Court.
18.	Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman has a son named Yasser Ali Mohammed.
19.	Yasser Ali Mohammed accompanied Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman when he surrendered to the International Criminal Court.
